3. Question: Should we use UCCSC as a venue for our annual ETLG meeting? – Jim Phillips
 - The University of California Computing Support Conference gathers administrative computing professionals from around the UC system in a different location each year to discuss computing issues. Historically, it has offered limited

educational technology resource talks and resources. For 2014, the steering committee has discussed an educational technology track.

- ETLG in-person meetings would take place before or after UCCSC, not at the same time.
 - Jim Phillips will send out an email to the ETLG asking for votes and feedback from representatives as to whether the ETLG should meet around UCCSC so as to conveniently rotate the in-person meeting of ETLG with minimal decision making required by the ETLG.
4. Question: Should we invite a rep. from USC as a guest to a future ETLG meeting or meet up? – Jim Phillips
- After discussion, it was decided not to invite a representative from USC to an ETLG meeting.
 - Instead, leveraging existing meetings of higher education technology directors, like DET/CHE, would be targeted for involving other institutions in ETLG.
