ANNOUNCEMENTS

- Minutes are now posted (removed references to three finalists in the RFP)
- Jeff - update on Course Materials fee – never did get approved but it was actually funded with other \$\$ (augment by \$9 million over 3 years). It was a direct result of Jeff asking for the tech fee money.

Review of Charge Letters

A few groups are making progress – primary liaisons need to finalize charges so that we can begin an ETLG level review with final discussions at our September meeting.

As a group, ETLG will look over all the charges – to ensure that we are focusing on what we need to do, draw connections / eliminate redundancies with other groups. **Update: workgroup chairs will also be asked to review charge letters of all other workgroups to look for areas of crossover.**

Area of concern: starting another site to collaborate (it gets to be too much). IDFS would like to start a blog / collaborative site to support OIPP. EAA is using Google Docs. Learning Spaces – may want a site to house repository of learning space docs. Need to consider the notion of a common repository, plus how ETLG would suggest aggregating all of this info / links to other sites. For now, we can focus on building out the ETLG site in spaces. Future consideration will be needed.

Review of Current Topics

- Currently on ETLG Web Site
 - Pedagogical Issues (should we organize a UC wide event next year?)
 - Agreed:** Initiate some prelim discussions with thought leaders
 - IDFS would like to have a similar conversations
 - “Rethinking the link between academic issues and Ed Tech folks”
 - Leverage OIPP
 - Stress underinvestment in educational technology, build profiles
 - Online Course Evaluations
 - Survey info compiled – reports forthcoming.
 - Virtual Labs
 - Survey info compiled – reports forthcoming.

- Possible other topics for 2011-12 or the future
 - Accessibility – EALT (Chaired by Christine Bagwell) – collecting scans of websites at each campus, web accessibility tool
 - Outreach to Library groups
 - eTexts - How do we want to consume eContent. UC Press is looking for a future model – Slasiac will consider this too. Google pilot.
 - Faculty roundtable: What are faculty doing across the UCs on Digital Humanities?

Copyright Update

- Presented to ITLC for comment
- Presented to OGC for comment
- Possible future presentations to UC committees (UCEP, SLASIAC, etc.)
- Proposed next steps for 2011-12:
 - **Proposed:** Participate on task force to update “Instructional Materials” policy (Jim and Mara and...?) – via SLASIAC
 - **Proposed:** Encourage development of common UCOP level web site on copyright issues / consolidate any sites under our control and point to UCOP level information whenever possible
 - **Proposed:** Encourage (mandatory) training on copyright as part of the Working Smarter efforts via Dan Greenstein / David Ernst / Mary MacDonald
 - Look for ways to use each others’ information

ETLG will need to think about how what this training is / should look like.

Have discussion at the local level – Let OIPP take another step forward, then revisit copyright in the spring – maybe as an ETLG sponsored an event. Possible inclusion in Pedagogical Issues discussions.

UCLA / UCI / UCB (within Sakai) require acknowledgement of copyright permission status at the point of upload – faculty have to check off what the copyright status is. No central copyright services at UCLA.

OIPP Update from Kirk / Mara

- RFP selection – *And the winner is:*
- OIPP – will continue to be in our focus and drive discussions on our campuses and drive change on a number of fronts
 - Develop a common resource for faculty to house resources (webinars, faculty success stories, faculty support information, calendar of events across our campus CTLs, etc.)
 - Instructional Applications workgroup to engage once an LMS is selected
- Linda Smeltzer and Kathy Zellars + Kirk = 3 FTEs involved
- Also, junior instructional designers to help – soon to be hired
- Kathy has been focusing on campus level capacity
- Goal: Have a point person from the campus and point person at OIPP on each course
- Identifying issues and challenges course by course
- Plenty of funds to staff out and fill gaps
- RFP Update – we won’t get the partnership that we hoped to get from a commercial vendor. Closing the RFP and OIPP will become the general contractor (combo of in-sourcing and outsourcing). Want to get off the ground quickly while engaging with 3rd party vendors for the future. UCB will host Sakai, UCLA will host Moodle. Implement Sakai OAE as gateway entry to the courses. Leverages investments made on the campuses already. For example, no vendor had the analytics needed.

FYI: Analytics for ALEKS was done by UCI folks – that might be helpful

Next Gen Learning Challenge grants were also focused on analytics, so that might be an avenue

Mara will send a diagram of the OIPP

UCLA has various groups focusing on the future of online instruction

Gail indicated that discussions on offering online programs are occurring at UCSF
