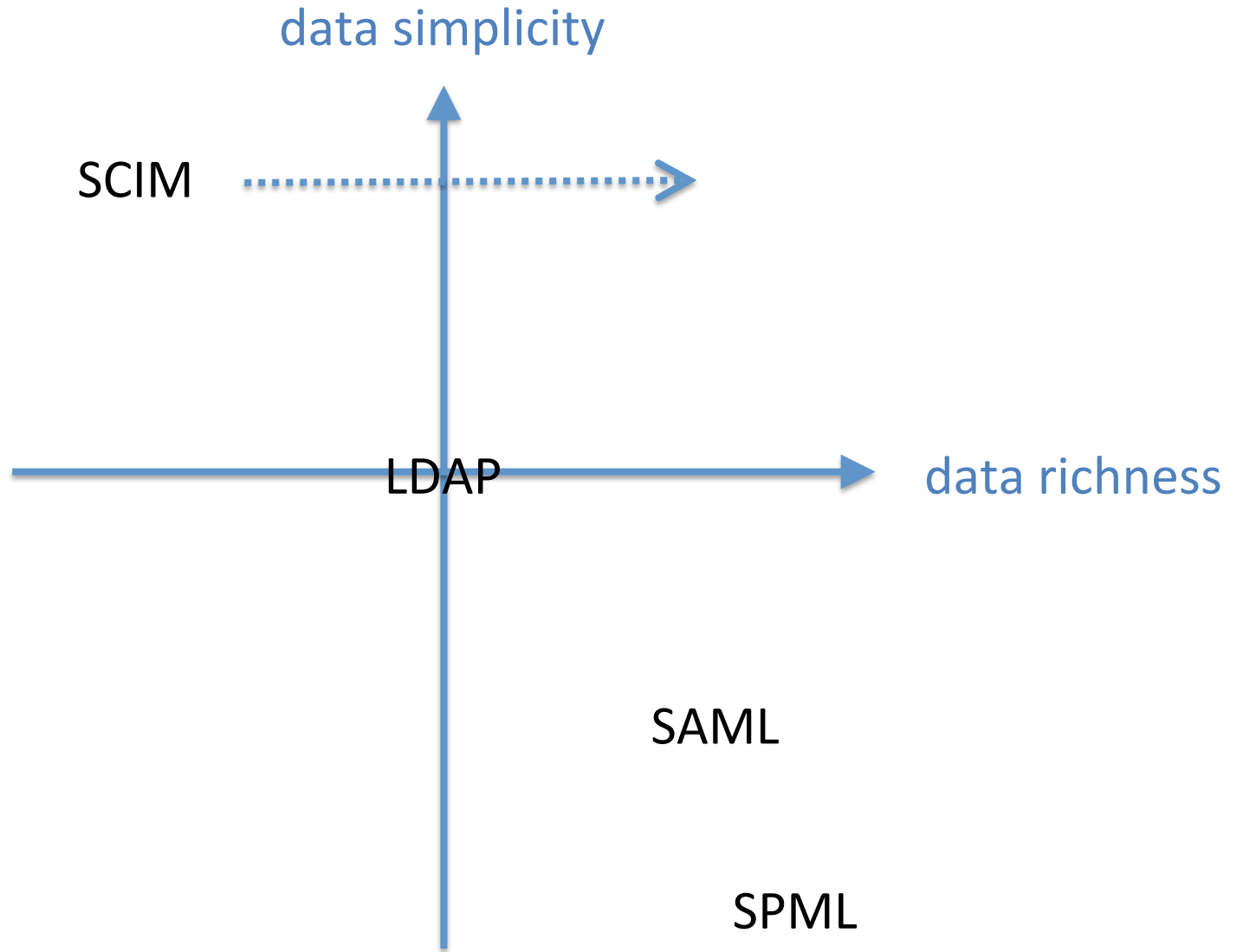

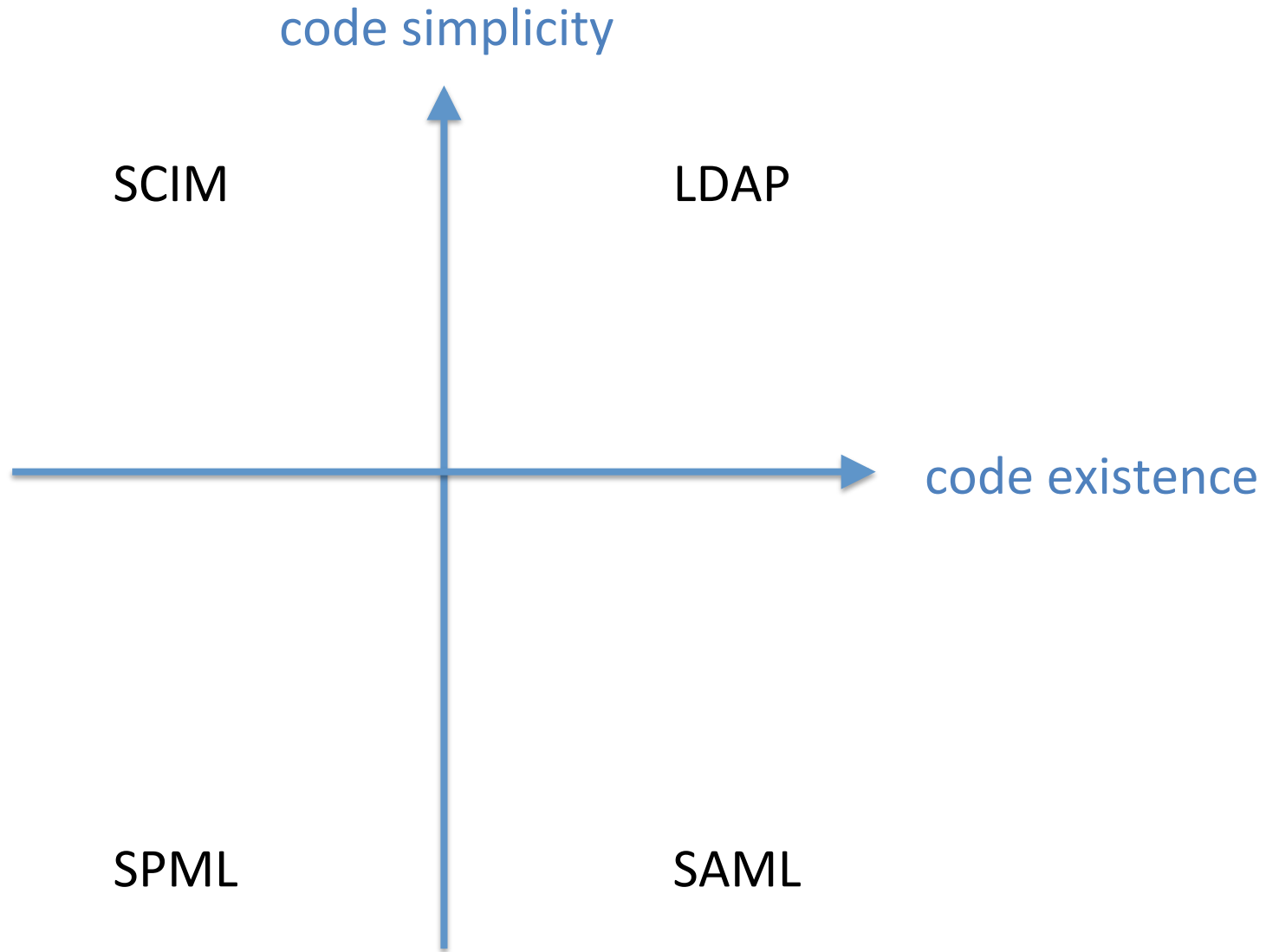

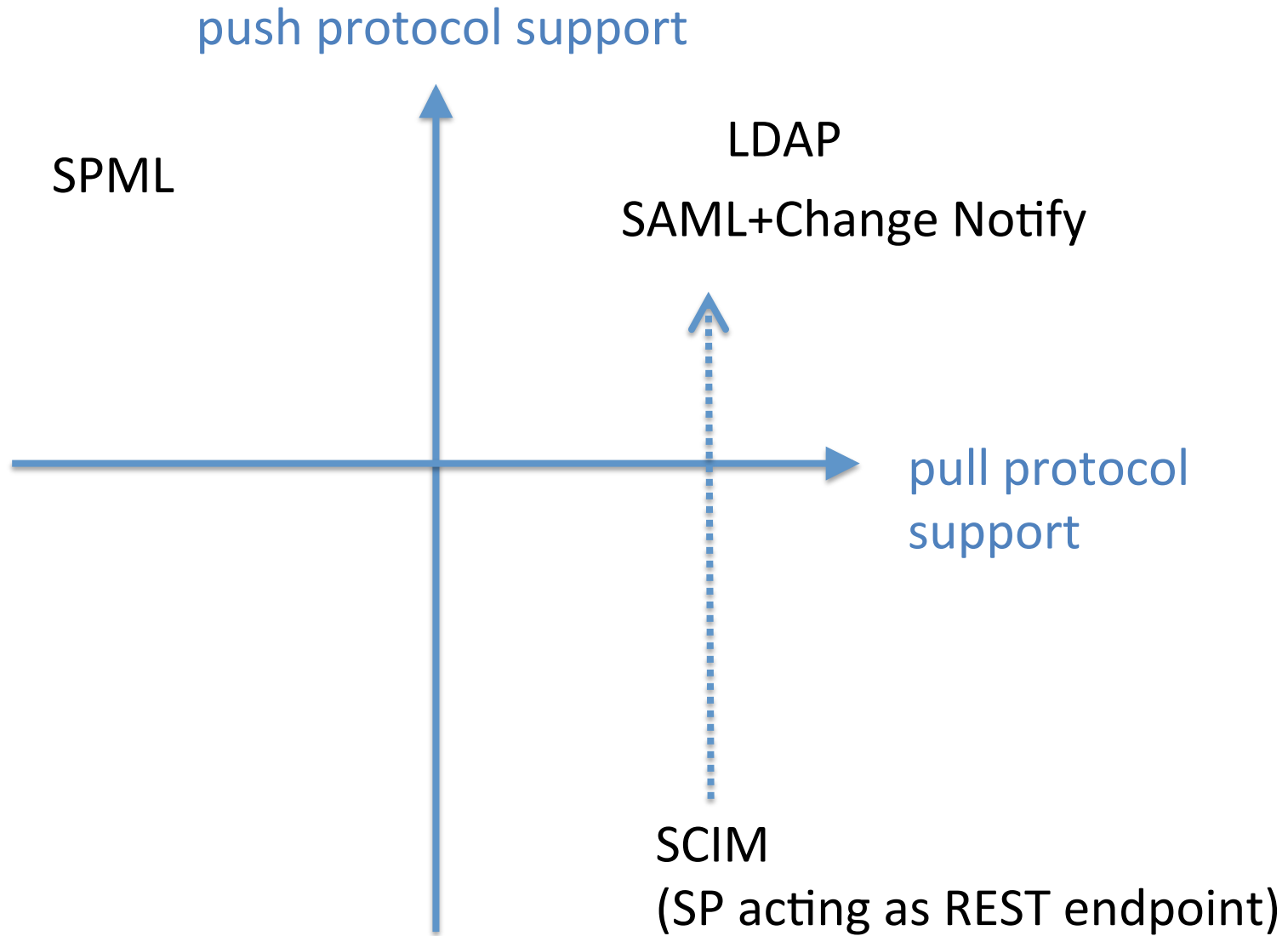
Assumptions :

- Attribute Release Policies are fully baked

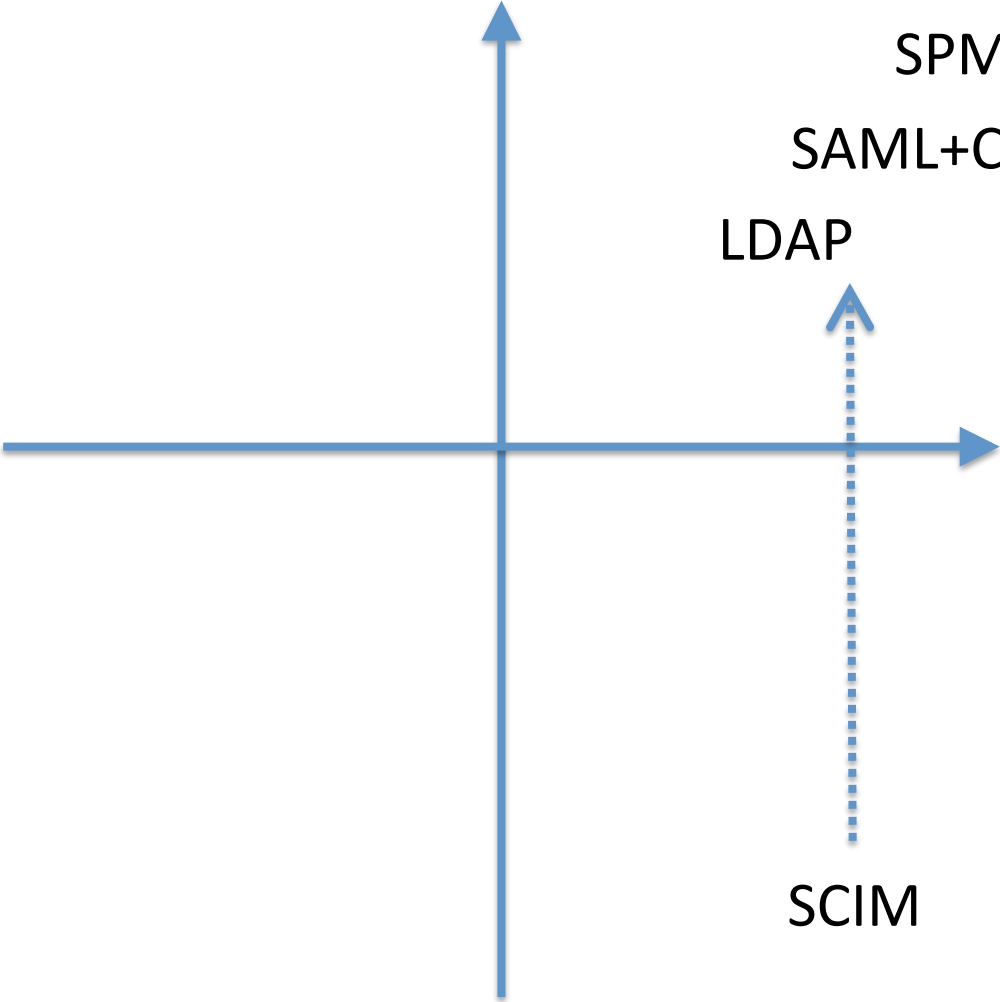
The dotted lines indicate work that needs to be done locally to encourage cloud participation.

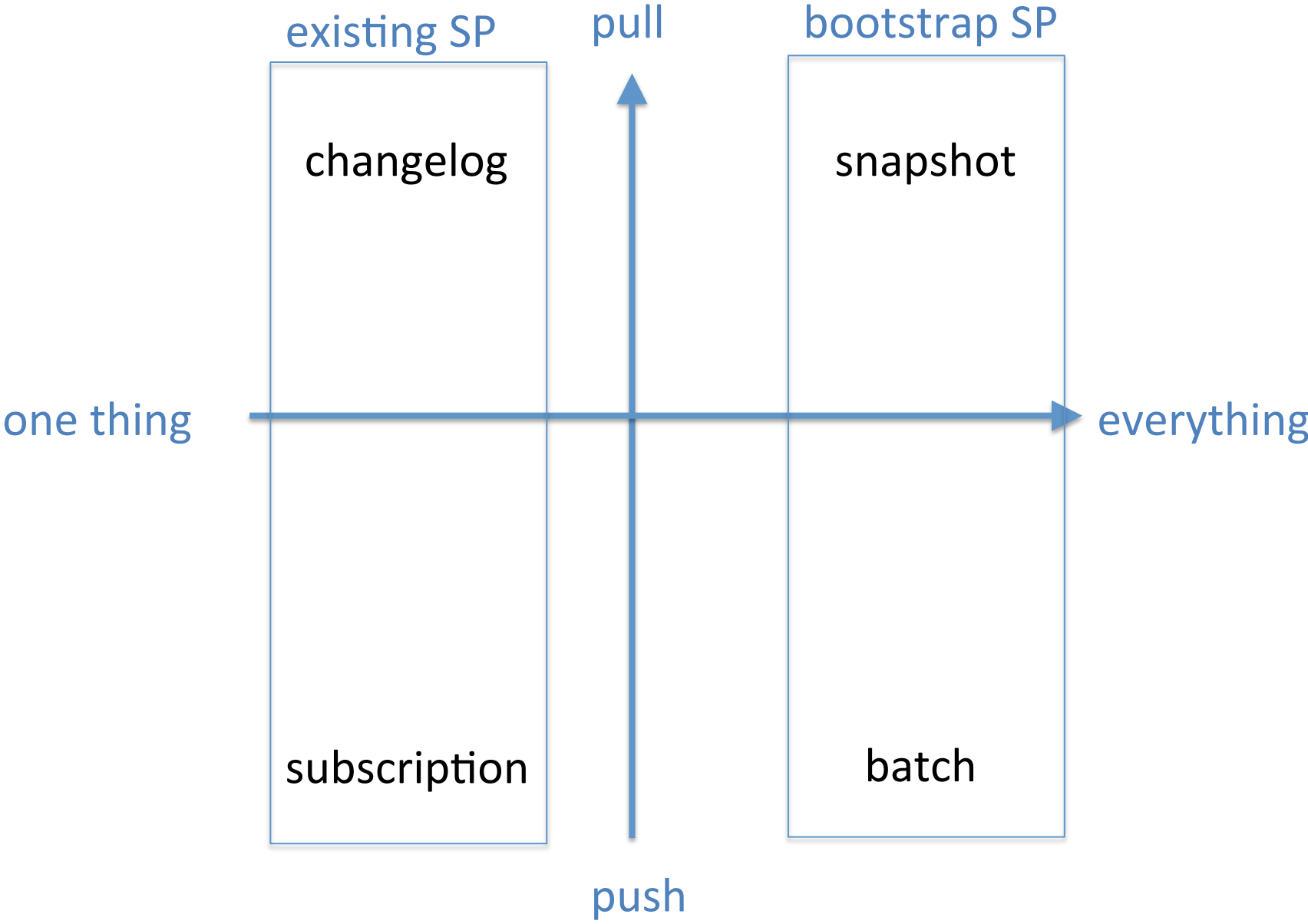

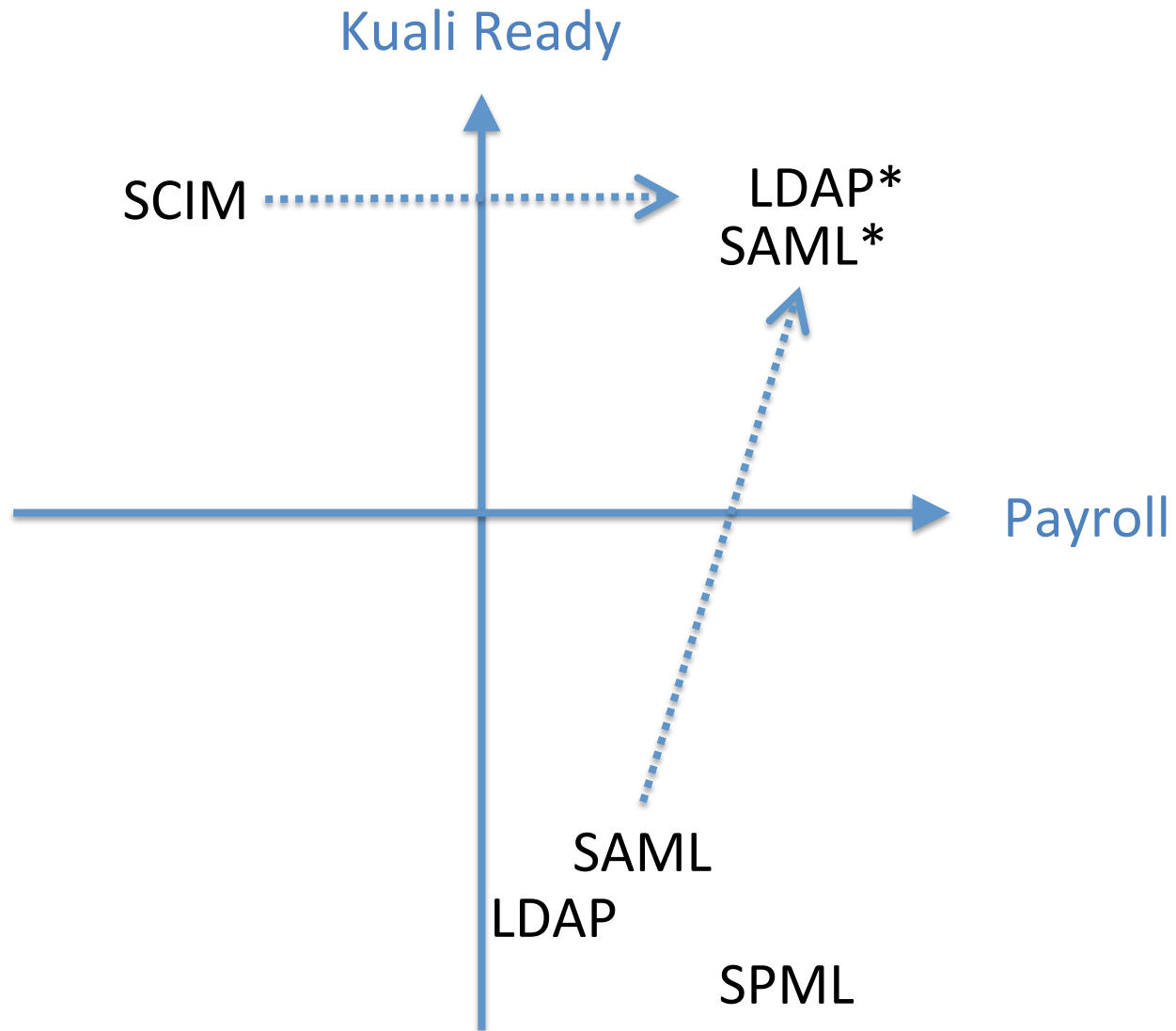

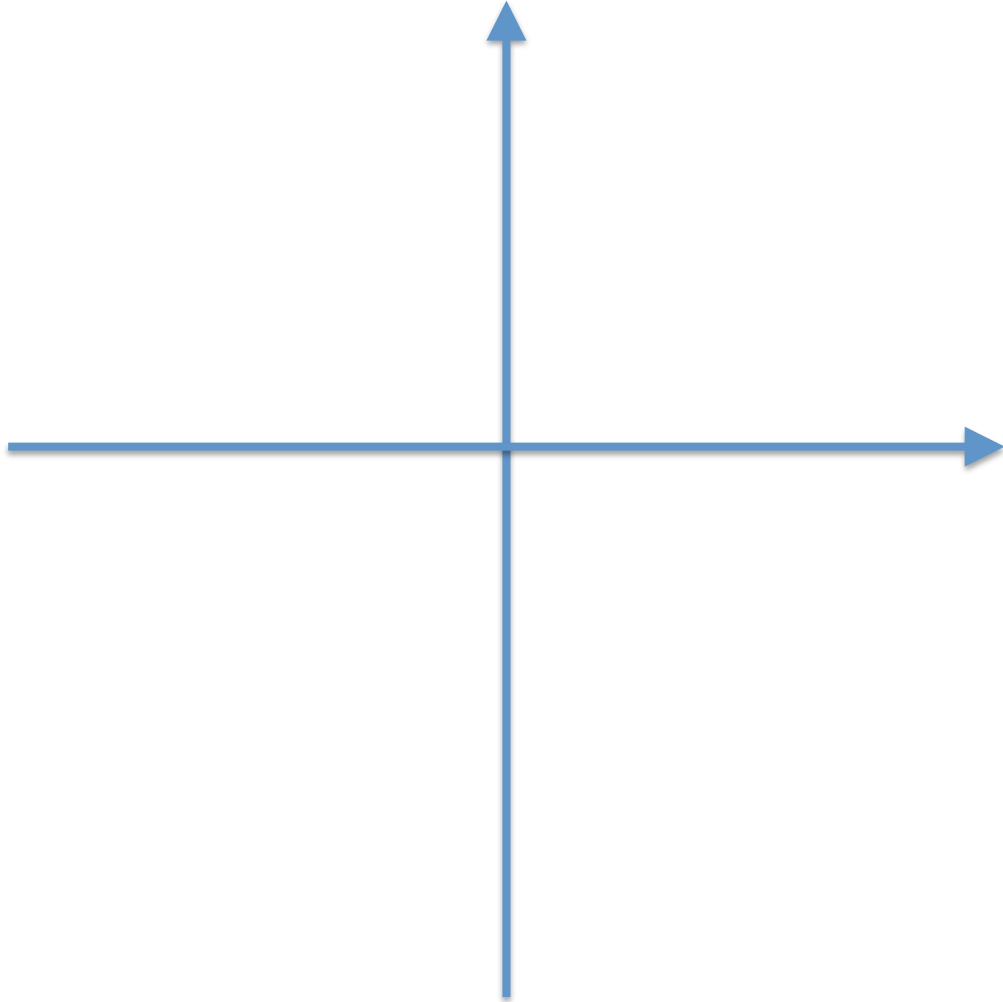

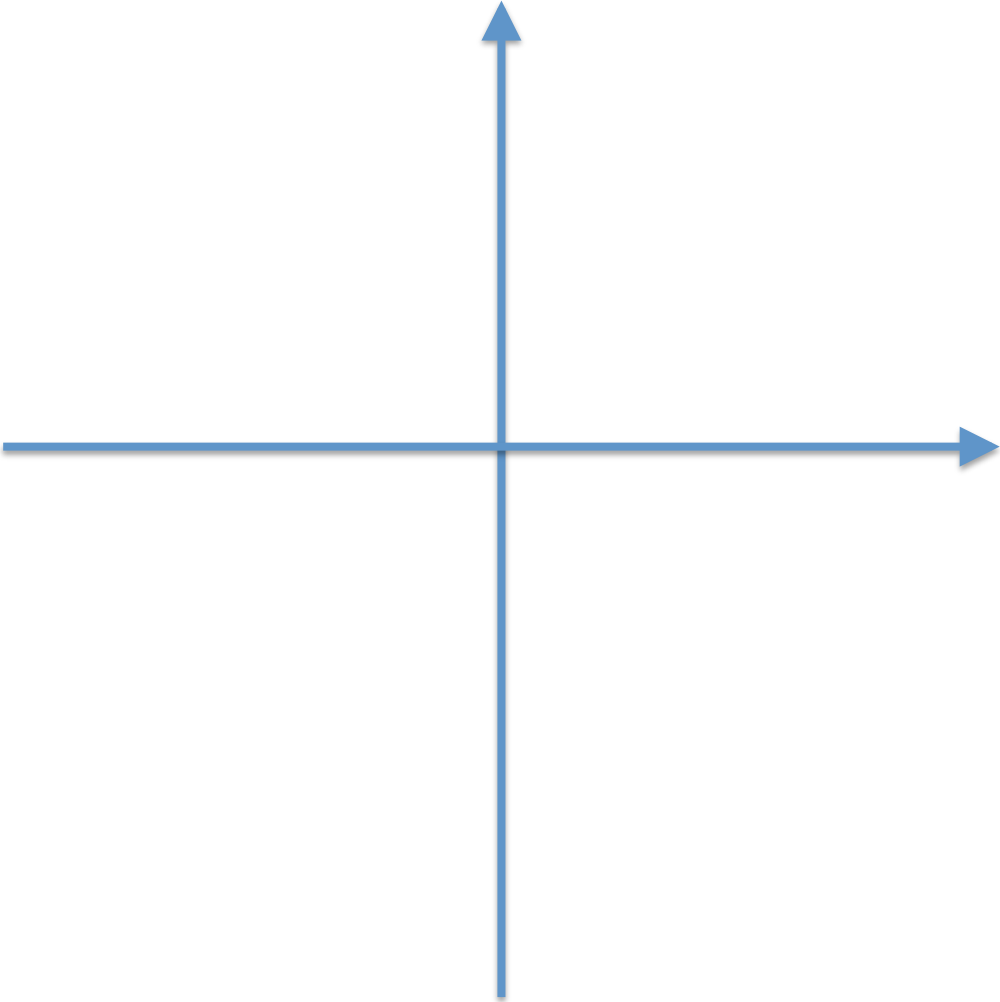
