Year 1: ILTI Awards

- <u>Campus Awards</u>- for infrastructure and at least one new campus online course (\$150K/campus, \$100K/course)
- Course Awards 39 courses received funding per submitted / approved budgets (range: \$12K - \$135K)
- <u>Cross-Campus Instructional Funds</u>- for TA's anticipated to support cross-campus students, instructor \$. Campus discretion on how to allocate funds.
- <u>Course Revision Funds</u>- block of funding for subsequent revisions of ILTI-approved courses. Campus discretion on how to allocate funds.
- Instructional Tool Awards for development of specific tools with open license and reuse potential across numerous online courses

ILTI Award Process

- Funding and guidelines delivered to the EVC and/or designee, approved budgets to faculty
- Course awards intended for department in which approved online course resides
 - Department to distribute payments to individuals and teams developing online courses
- Campus internal processes for requesting other funding may differ
 - Includes infrastructure, "new course", TA funding, etc.
 - Request should start with EVC or designee
- Reporting to UCOP every six months
 - Specific formats for reporting budgeted work and "in kind contributions" distributed to EVC and/or designee

New Course RFP 2014-2015

- RFP to be issued September, 2014
- 4-6 weeks for faculty response → mid October
 - Proposal, budget format revised to streamline efforts
 - ILTI criteria to be outlined explicitly in RFP
 - Online courses / no hybrids
- Course proposal /budget reviews October December 2014
- Course Awards confirmed January 2015
- Award distribution January/February 2015

Year 1: Cross Campus Enrollment

- Launched "Mini-Hub" November, 2013
- Launched Cross-Enrollment website November, 2013
