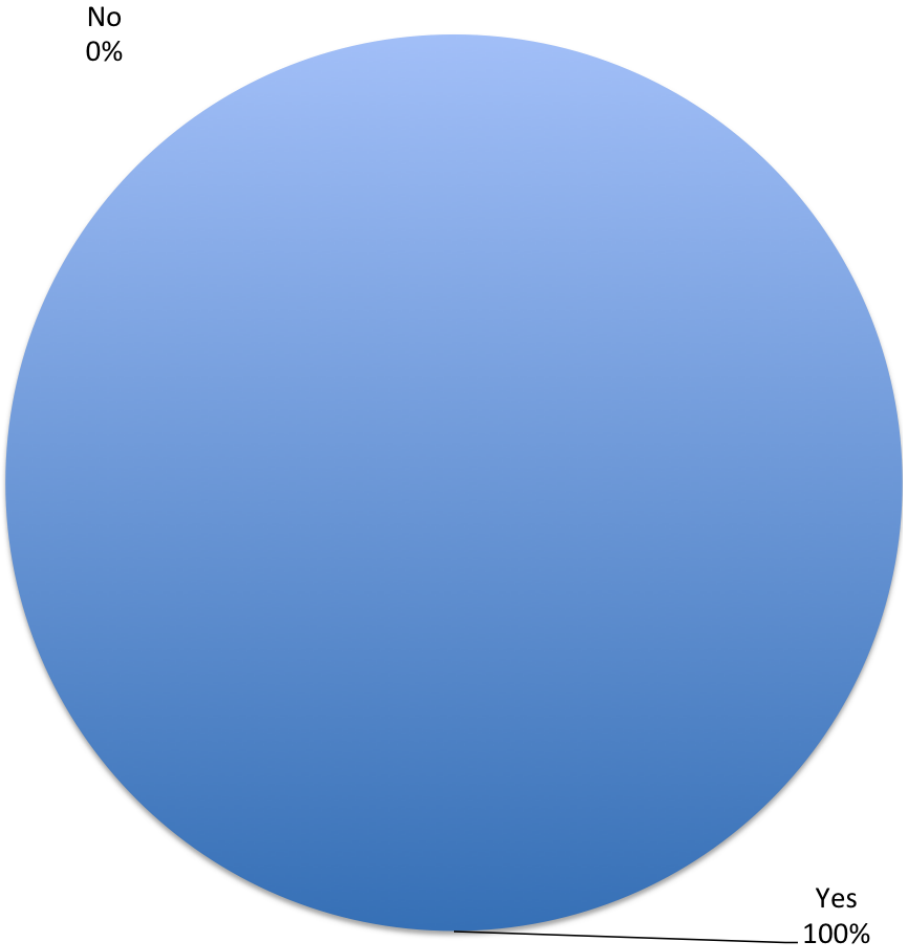


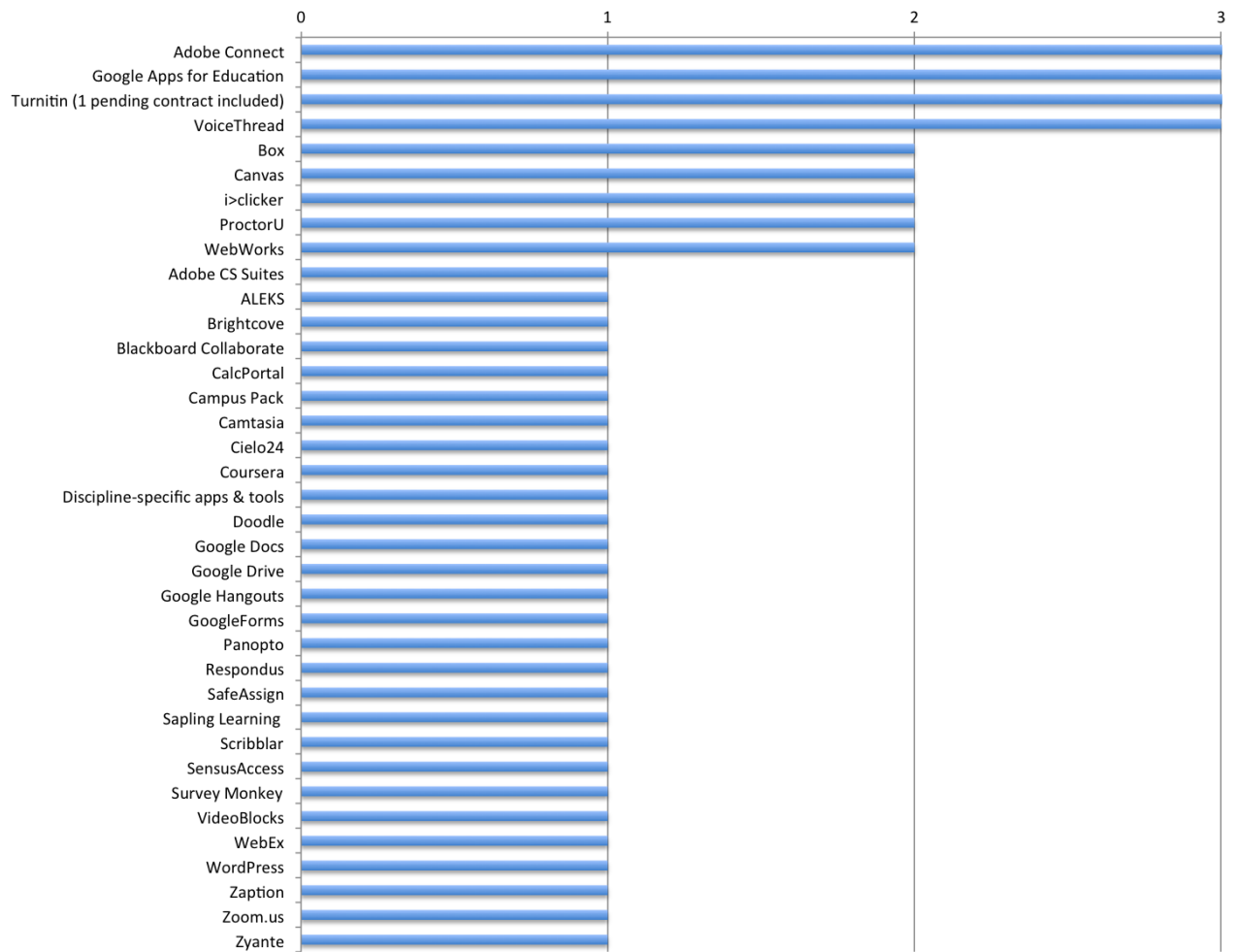

- 2. Is your campus currently using any licensed third-party tools?



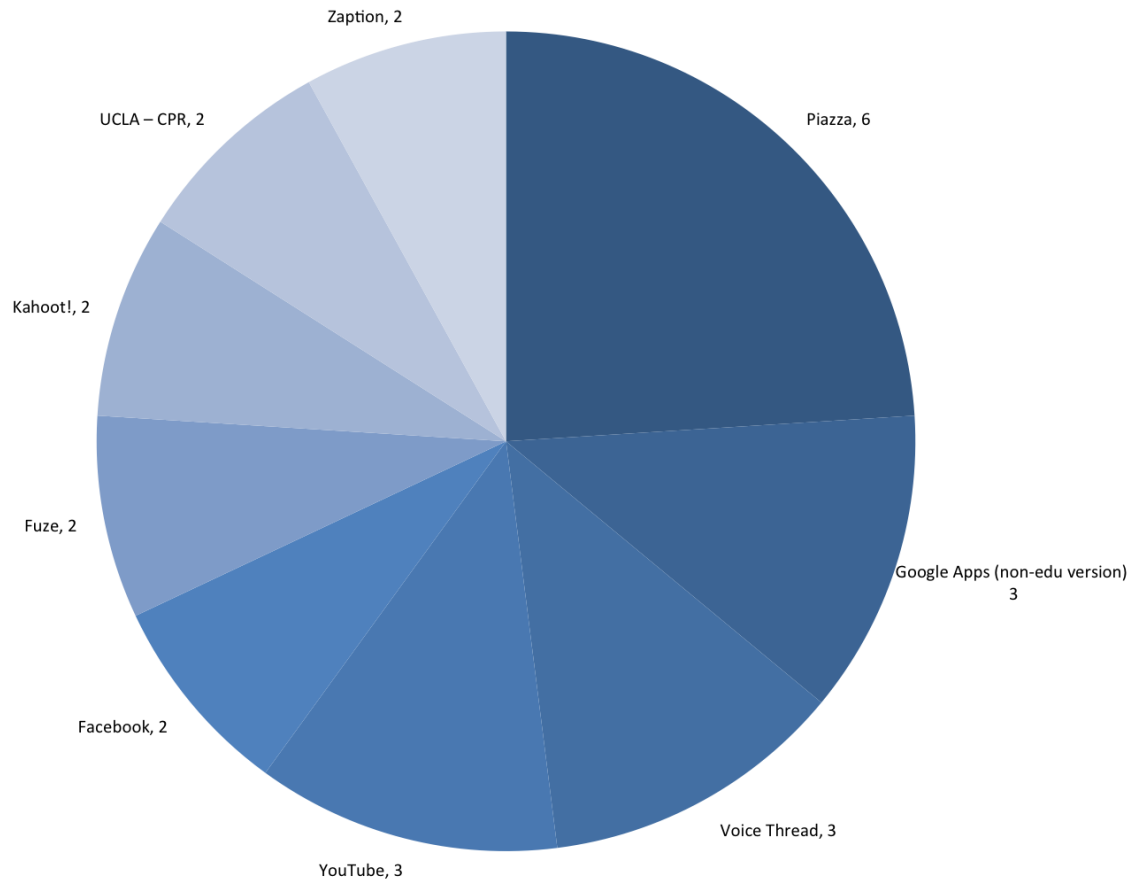
3. Licensed third-party tools currently being used

Licensed Tools by Number of Campuses



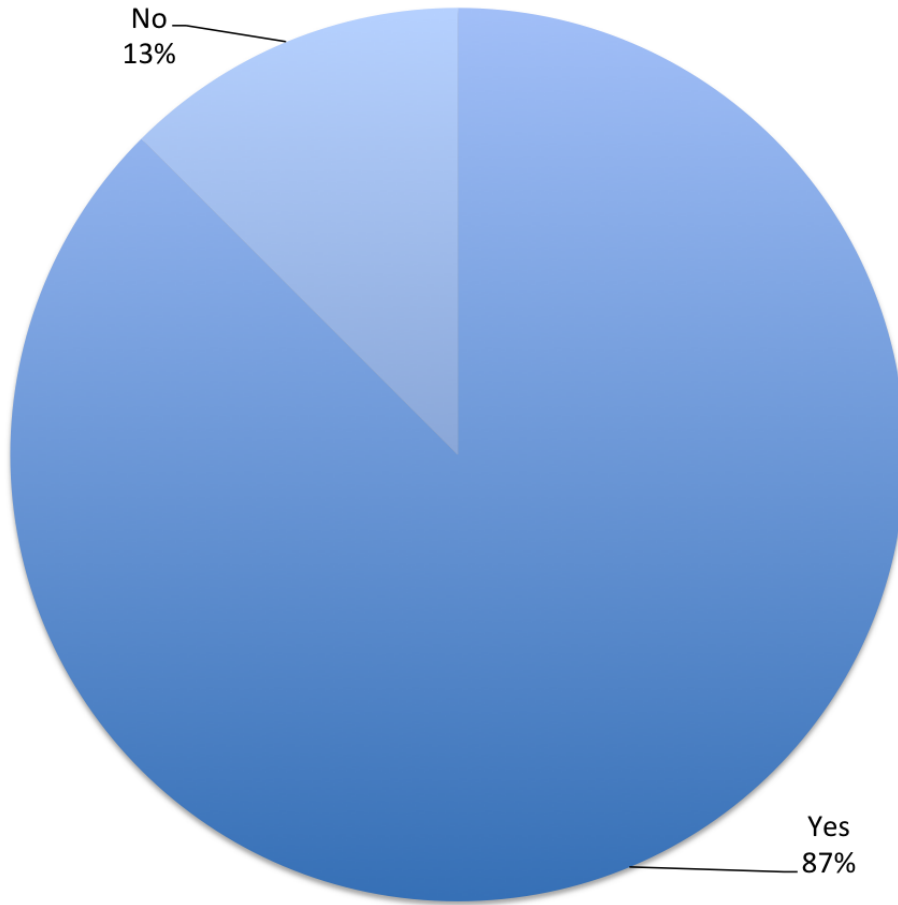
4. Not licensed third-party tools currently used by faculty

Non-Licensed Third-Party Tool Use by Number of Campuses



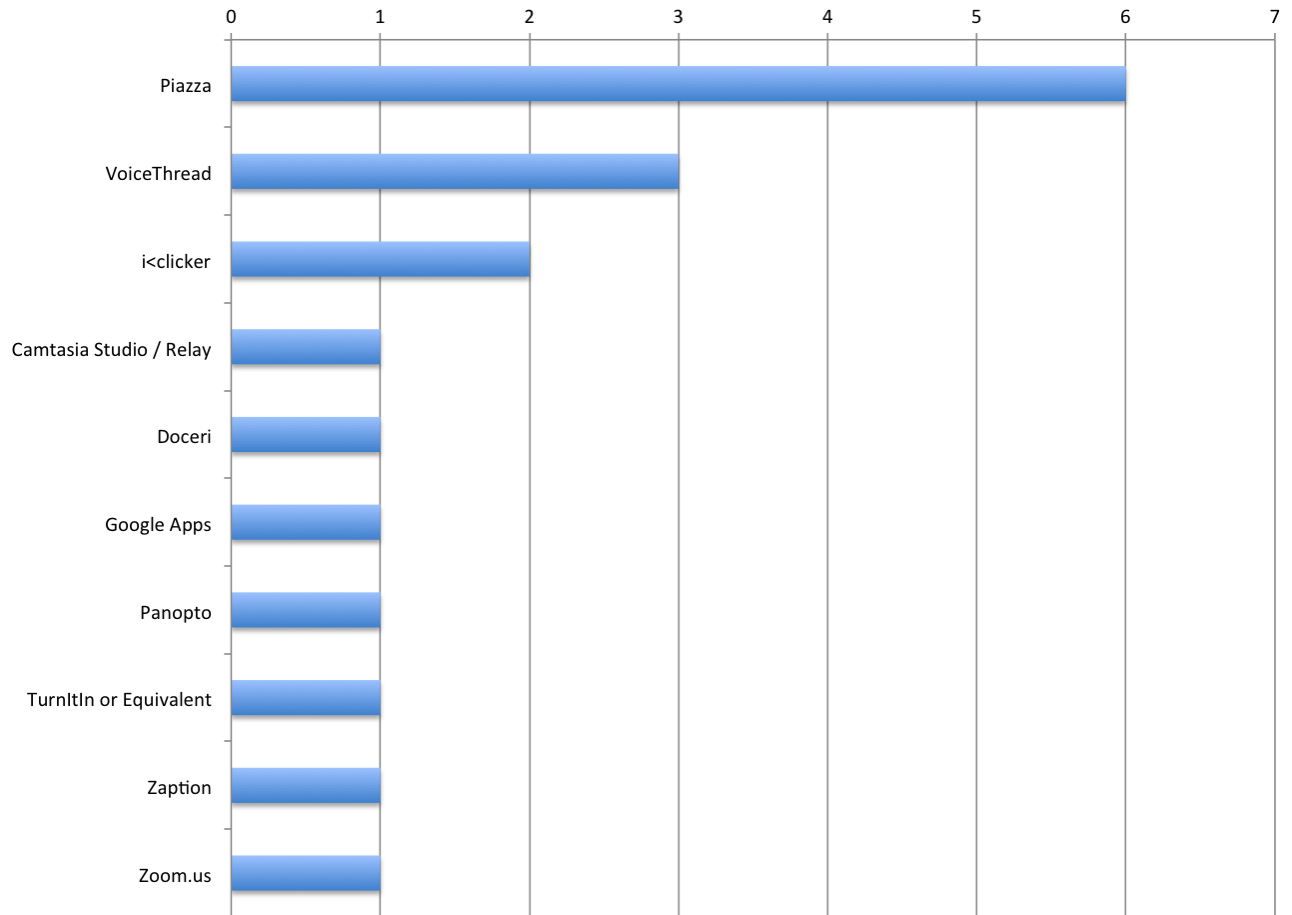

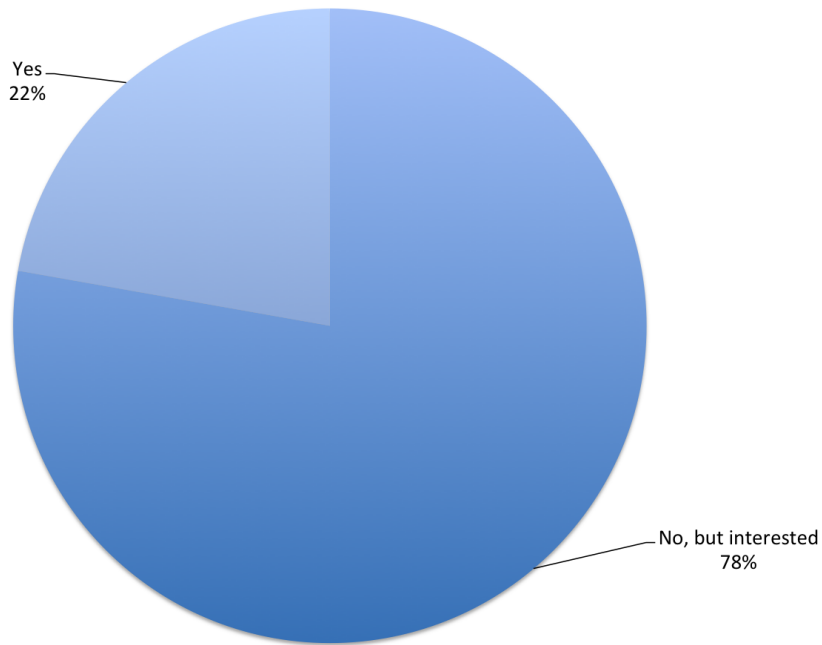


6. If yes, what are the top 3 priorities?
