 - b. Tom Trappier leading negotiations with support group.
 - c. Piazza using several campus branding without permission; consider asking legal to remove the Cal logo
 - d. Possibly have individual campuses reach out to Pooja (Piazza CEO) directly and warn (Plan B) - discourage its use, advise faculty, develop our own, use LTI (into LMS) to anonymize student identity at the vendor (embed engagement meter inside LMS course)
 - Pitch it as a way to get better data back to faculty on tool usage by using the CASA engagement meter
